

## **NEWS – MARCH 16, 2009**

### **Executive Committee Meeting**

The Executive Committee of the KVFOA met on Sunday, March 1<sup>st</sup> at 1:30 pm. Present were Mike Beller (President), Dan Sizemore (Vice President), John Hudson (Secretary/Treasurer), Alan “Pacman” Settle (Assignment Commissioner), Jeff Tanner (Member at Large) and Joey Hager (Assignment Commissioner). John Wilson was invited to attend to address matters concerning the website.

President Beller led a discussion on locations for future meetings. The concern is to make the venue centrally located to the membership and to be able to accommodate the group size. Members will contact venues and make a determination before the next meeting. Meeting times were discussed and it was decided to make meeting times for 7:00 pm for Monday meetings and to 6:30 pm when the schedule changes to Tuesday meetings.

President Beller discussed the selection of members to teach Rookie School. Several suggestions were given, including the recommendation that officers should not teach, thus allowing other members the opportunity to teach. Several individuals were recommended and committee members will contact them to see if they are interested.

Secretary/Treasurer Hudson discussed a minimum game fee list and the need to establish a list as a reference point to publish for the membership.

President Beller discussed planning for a Clinic to take place in June, in conjunction with a school holding a 7-on-7 tournament. Possible sites were discussed and a report on a possible site will be presented at the next meeting. Joey and Jeff are leading this effort.

Secretary/Treasurer Hudson read a communication from a member concerning whether the KVFOA had an “inactive fee”. It was also asked the amount of the annual membership fee for the KVFOA, when other organizations are not that high. Secretary/Treasurer Hudson said that the KVFOA does not have an “inactive fee”. Secretary/Treasurer Hudson said any fee change requires a membership vote. Hudson said he would review the numbers to substantiate the current fee level.

President Beller discussed the Blake Wood Award and called the Committee’s attention to Greg Wyatt’s piece on the website and encouraged feedback to Greg.

John Wilson shared a piece out of Referee magazine about assigning games and asked Pac and Joey if they would be interested in putting together some positives and negatives when working with someone assigning games for the website.

Secretary/Treasurer Hudson read a card from Judy Wood expressing her thanks to the membership of the KVFOA and their donation to Hospice in Blake’s memory.

The meeting adjourned at 3:30 pm.
