

MEETING CREDITS

Meeting credits will strictly follow the WVSSAC Officials Handbook.

First, you must attend four Local Board Meetings (See Page 15 of Handbook), and the meetings must consist of one hour of rules interpretation and/or mechanics (See Page 20).

Second, additional points may be received for camps or sport-specific clinics which have received WVSSAC approval (See Page 20).

Third, a Local Board Meeting is considered by the WVSSAC to be at the home Board of the member. To receive credit for attending meetings at other Boards, you must request permission, in advance, according to Roberta Newton.

To clarify:

- Clinic attendance will not count as Local Board Meeting attendance. Clinic attendance will count in addition to four Local Board Meetings attended. The WVSSAC will allow two meeting credits for attendance at the KVFOA Clinic.
- Attending a Business Meeting alone will not count for meeting credits.
- The WVSSAC will grant one meeting credit for teaching Rookie School. This credit will count in addition to four Local Board Meetings attended.

You are responsible for monitoring your attendance on the website.
